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About the Convention

Date and Location

Date: 27 – 29 October 2010

Venue: Shandong Hotel, Jinan, China

Format

The Convention will cover two full days and will feature:

- A plenary opening session with **high level key note** addresses from the People's Republic of China: Minister and Vice Minister of Transport; as well as the Normach of Shandong Province
- **Expert plenary sessions** on the following topics:
 - o the importance of rural roads and their role in economic development, social cohesion and poverty reduction
 - o planning and managing rural roads
 - o construction and maintenance of rural roads
 - o rural road safety awareness, engineering and enforcement
- **Three high level panel discussions: Financing Rural Roads, Standard Specifications for Rural Roads and Safe Rural Roads**, featuring representatives from international finance institutions, donor agencies and national governments.

The Convention will be preceded by a **Capacity Building workshop on Urban Mobility & Environment**, organised by gTKP, on Tuesday 26th of October. This workshop has a limited number of participants and has a separate registration procedure.

The Convention will be held in **English**; simultaneous translation into **English/Chinese** and **Chinese/English** will be provided.

Participants

The targeted number of Convention delegates is 300. The Convention is open to road sector practitioners and stakeholders from both the public sector and the private sector. It is to be expected that the larger share of participants will come from the Asian Region such as:

- Government and Municipal agencies
- International financial institutions
- Construction companies
- Infrastructure operators
- Environment engineers
- Consulting engineers and management consultants
- Educational and training institutions

Prior to the official opening of the Convention, a special question and answer session will be organised with the Minister of Transport of China. This meeting will be open exclusively to Convention sponsors. This face-to-face meeting is an exclusive opportunity to ask questions on China's current challenges and future plans in the complex and vitally important sector of transport.
