

Sibylle Rupprecht, Director IRF Geneva, address the First National Congress on Highways, Turkey

Sibylle Rupprecht was invited as the only foreign panellist to address the First National Congress on Highways, organised by the Turkish Road Association from 1-3 April 2008.
